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
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
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Arctic Project Field Sites 1999- 2010



Services Available through RSL

- Arctic Research Support and Logistics Contractor – CH2M HILL Polar Services (CPS)
 - Planning support for proposers – scope, budget, risk assessment
 - Equipment in inventory – camping gear, snowmobiles, ice augers
 - Procurement – equipment, services like guides and bear guards
 - Air contract support, fixed wing and helicopter
 - Ice camp support
 - Barrow area logistics support
 - Environmental compliance
 - Technical support for instrument design and deployment through SRI
 - Project management oversight of support delivery
- Other Research Support Providers
 - USCG Icebreaker and other research vessel support
 - Air contracts
 - GPS and Iridium support
 - Russian tourist camp at North Pole, Barneo



How to use Logistics through NSF

 - Develop scope of work, schedule, budget, risk assessment
 - Make sure these costs are accounted for in proposal
